## Rates

Superior Court Ordered Civil Mediations:

- Civil Limited: \$150 per hour for each of the first two hours and \$400 per hour thereafter.
- Civil Unlimited: \$250 per hour for each of the first two hours and \$400 per hour thereafter.

HOA rate: \$800/3 hours + \$400 for each additional hour. There is a \$125 per party administrative fee.

All other: Mr. Boss' hourly rate is \$400. His rates for half- and full-day sessions are as follows:

Half Day:

- 5 hour minimum (this includes 1 hour review of briefs, pre-mediation call with Counsel, and 4 hours of session time) - \$2,000
- \$195 per party administrative fee

Full Day:

- 10 hour minimum (this includes 2 hours review of briefs, pre-mediation call with Counsel, and 8 hours of session time) - \$4,000
- \$195 per party administrative fee
